HPV RISKS & PREVENTION



HPV stands for human papillomavirus.

Out of over 100 types of HPV, 2 types are responsible for 70% of cervical cancer.

Here's why the HPV vaccination is important for your daughter, and works best when given at a younger age.

Those younger than 15 years old require 2 doses; while those aged between 15 and 26 require 3 doses



HPV vaccines can be given safely together with other vaccines

HPV is the leading cause of the most common female cancer (cervical cancer)
