National School-based Human Papillomavirus Vaccination Programme for Secondary Two Female Students (Second/Third Dose) in Privately Funded Schools

1. Last year, your daughter/ward would have received the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine that helps to prevent cervical cancer.
2. The Health Promotion Board's (HPB) appointed vendor will be visiting your daughter's/ward's school to administer the second/third dose of the HPV vaccine.
3. HPV vaccination will be conducted during the annual school-based health screening.
4. Your daughter/ward may be asked to stay back in the afternoon to receive the vaccination in school to minimise disruption to the school curriculum. If she misses the vaccination in school, she will be given an appointment to receive the vaccination at HPB's appointed service provider's clinic.
