Dear Parents, Students and Guardians,

Since the start of the week we have continued to introduce further measures to implement the social distancing of students throughout the school. We would like to thank all students who have respected the new procedures that have been put in place.

On Tuesday 24 March the Singapore Government banned gatherings of over 10 people in order to further enhance social distancing efforts. These new restrictions do not apply to in school activities. However, to avoid large gatherings at the school beyond normal hours as of Wednesday 25 March we will be requiring all students to leave the school campus and head immediately home at the end of school or formal support time. That means that students are no longer be able remain after school to use the sporting facilities, canteen, library and other school resources.

We ask that you continue to speak to your child\ward about the importance of respecting social distancing. Students who do not observe our social distancing measures, will receive a warning and if they persist will be sent home from school.
