

Dear Student and Parents/Guardian,

On behalf of the entire school we would like to welcome your family to ACS (International).

This letter sets out the orientation programme that has been planned for Monday 4 January and Tuesday 5 January. We would normally run an onsite parent session throughout these days, but due to Safe Management Measures in relation to COVID-19, this year we have had to amend this part of the programme and move it online.

#### **Online Sessions**

There will be two sessions that parents can view during the orientation:

- Pre-recorded welcome message from the school, along with information about the school.
- Video of student orientation day to be uploaded a few days after orientation.

These videos will be uploaded to <u>ACS (International)'s official page on Facebook</u>. We recommend that you 'like' the school's Facebook site as school events and news are often promoted through this channel.

You may also consider 'like-ing' the <u>ACS (International) Parent School Partner (PSP) page on Facebook</u> as well, as the PSP publish information that is specific for parents of the school.

Supplement to the information provided in the 2021 Weclome Pack, the school programme for 4 and 5 January has been fine-tuned to work with the Safe Management Measures.

### **Monday 4 January – Parents and Students, Uniform and Textbook Purchase**

The school is open for parents and students to come onsite to purchase school uniforms and required textbooks. To manage the number of people on-site, each family has been given a time slot based on the House that their child has been placed in:

CKS and GHK - 9:30am- 11:00am LSG and OLD - 11:00am-12:30pm SVM and TCT - 12:30pm-2:00pm THO and TKK - 2:00pm - 3:30pm

The school will be following up with you with detils relating to your child's house assignment shortly.

If you are unable to make the sessions times above, the uniform suppliers will also be onsite on Wednesday 6 January and Friday 15 January. Appontment times are not required for these sessions so you can just come when is convenient.

Uniform purchases can also be made by visiting the physical <u>Bibi and Baba store</u> or online through the <u>ACS (International) Uniform Shop.</u>

If there is any enrolment paperwork that needs finalizing parents can complete this on this day as well.

#### **Tuesday 5 January – Student Orientation**

Orientation camp on 5 January is organized and led by the student leaders with the aim to induct new students to the school community and facilitate interaction among the new students as well as with senior students and some key staff.

Registration commenced at 8:30am with all students expected to report by 8:45am. Students are to wear PE kit or sports attire with covered, comfortable shoes.

Please take note that we will comply with safe distancing regulations as advised by the authorities. The programme may change accordingly based on the latest advisory.

#### **Administration Matters**

Please prepare your child to submit the completed consent/indemnity form on 4 January during registration together with a payment of \$30 as Orientation fee (payment can be made at Orientation Registration booth on 4 or 5 January). This fee covers the costs of Orientation camp, including meals and an orientation pack. (Payment mode: cash or cheque (pay to "ACS (International) Singapore")

The programme for 6 to 9 January is outlined in our 2021 Welcome Pack and will remain unchanged.
