#### **IBDP Admissions of Non-DSA IGCSE students**

For a number of students the IGCSE results will be used to determine whether they will be enrolled into the IB Diploma programme at ACS (International). Students and parents can find the school's Student Progression Policy on the website under "Life at ACS -> Community Policies". However, in simple terms, students need to achieve 2As, 2Bs and 2Cs in a combination that allows for an IB group of subjects to be selected.

Please note that enrolments are extremely limited in both Psychology and Sports, Health and Exercise Science.

### **Progression Procedure on Wednesday 20 January**

For students wishing to pursue IB studies or for those who need assistance finding a new education provider, there will be counsellors available on the day. Students and parents are invited to come in the morning to discuss progression. For students and parents who cannot make it in the morning they should call the school's main reception on 8472 1477 and arrange a time for later in the day.

The main IBDP subject consultation will take place from 8.45am to 12.30pm.

## **Support for Students who do not meet IBDP Progression Criteria**

Students who do not meet the minimum criteria for progression to IBDP will be directed to the Higher Education staff for advice on other educational options. Staff will be available from 8:45am to 1:00pm.

### **Optional Higher Education Guidance Session**

The Higher Education and Careers department will be running two short sessions that guide students on using university entrance criteria to choose IB subjects. The sessions will last about 20 minutes are optional to attend.

The sessions will run at 9am and 10:30am in Oldham Chapel on Wednesday 20 January.

### **IBDP Induction Sessions**

For those students who are admitted to the IBDP programme on the day, there is an Induction Programme starting at 2:00pm that is compulsory for them to attend.

On Thursday 21 January non-DSA students who have been successfully admitted will commence their IB studies. There is a further IB induction session that afternoon that will finish at 4:00pm.
