SMM – Phase 2 Heightened Measures

Dear Parents and Guardians,

On Sunday 16 May the Singapore Government moved the country to an increased set of restrictions, known as *Phase 2 – Heightened Restrictions*.

Please find below the adjustments that ACS (International) is making to comply with this new phase.

Canteen and Lunchtime

Student density will be further reduced in the canteens, with additional eating areas being provided.

The school is suspending Year 5 and 6 students from leaving the campus to go to Holland Village during school hours for the rest of Term 2. All Year 5 and Year 6 students will need to remain on campus during school hours, including at lunchtime.

The Canteen stalls will only be open during lunch times. They will be closed during or between lessons. Food deliveries are not permitted at school and will be turned away at the gate.

CCAs

All CCAs are suspended for the remainder of Term 2. Students may have to undertake online CCA meetings in place of on campus CCAs.

After School Curriculum Support

After school curriculum support will continue, but once finished students must leave the campus.

Library

The Library is reducing its after school capacity to a maximum of 30 students. Access will be given on a “first come, first served” basis for Year 4 and Year 6 students only.

After School – No students on campus

All students are to leave the campus immediately after school, unless they have support with a teacher or have gained access to the Library as outlined in the previous points.

Masks

As has already been the practice, all students and staff will need to wear masks at all times unless active in the process of eating or drinking. All teachers will wear masks and will teach from the front of the classroom only.

Free Periods

All students will need to be in the Library during study periods.
