School Update

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Last night I wrote a brief letter providing the school community with some quick clarity about how ACS (International) will respond to the MOE announcement regarding a move to Home Based Learning (HBL). Today I am writing to provide more detail about the arrangements for the remainder of Term 2.

Home Based Learning

External Exams

All external exams for the May and June sessions, such as IGCSE, O-Levels and IBDP will carry on as normal at the school. This is compliant with MOE's directives. Students who are sitting exams will be permitted to enter the school on these occasions.

School Reports and PTM

School Reports will still be released on Saturday 22 May and the PTM will occur on Monday 24 May as previously advertised. There will be no HBL on the PTM day as our teachers will be involved in the PTM.

Student on Campus

Students are not allowed on campus during the HBL period. However, if they have left something that they urgently need to pick up, they should contact the school and arrange a date and time when they can come to school and collect the item.

School Office Hours

School Office hours will change to be 8:00am to 4:00pm. Visitors are not allowed on the campus but you may still call the Office if required.

Thank you for your support during this time. We pray that the current situation might improve so that we can get back to Phase 3 as quickly as possible.
