COVID-19 Vaccination Exercise for Students in Schools – Update 11 June 2021

Dear Parents/Guardians of Graduating students,

MOH announced that from 11 Jun 2021 (Fri) onwards, the national vaccination programme will be extended to the rest of the population in the 12 to 39 age band, and that it will be implementing the enhanced consent requirement for the vaccination of minors below the age of 18.

Please note that the enhanced consent requirement will **not** apply to students from ACS (International), i.e. they do **not** need to bring along documentary proof of parental consent to the vaccination centre (VC). Students will just need to bring their student identification cards when registering at the VC, which will enable the VC staff to verify that these students are part of MOE's vaccination exercise. (**Note:** Students without their identification cards should bring along other forms of identification, e.g. NRIC/passport.)
