




Dear Parents & Guardians of ACSians

What do we do at CSLMCH?

CSLMCH has existed for more than 50 years. We provide care and protection to boys and girls between the ages of 5 and 21 years old.

Our Home is an approved Voluntary Welfare Organisation registered under the Charities Act and a full member of

the National Council of Social Services (NCSS). The Home has been accorded the Institution of Public Character Status (IPC) by the Ministry of Finance.

As a charity, we rely on donations from individuals and organisations to defray the costs of running the Home and to supplement the funding we receive from the government for our children's personal, educational and developmental needs.

Who will benefit from this fund-raiser?

Behind this fund-raiser are children from disadvantaged home environments and dire family situations. The CSLMCH is a residential home that serves as a haven of healing and restoration for them. Our aim is to give the children entrusted to our care a stronger and firmer start in life. Every child deserves this.
