COVID-19 Protocol Reminder

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Given the rise of cases in Singapore which is likely to continue, I am sending out a reminder to the school community about school protocols in relation to COVID-19.

Child has COVID-19 Symptoms

- Do not send the child to school. They will be on an Approved Absence (AA).
- They should contact a Doctor's Office and follow their advice.
- They may return to school when a negative ART test is provided.

Child receives a Health Risk Warning (HRW)

- Do not send the child to school. They will be on an Approved Absence (AA).
- They may return to school when their exit PCR test is negative.

A Household member of the Child receives a Health Risk Warning (HRW)

- Do not send the child to school. They will be on an Approved Absence (AA).
- The child may return when the child provides a negative ART test for themselves, the Household member entry PCR test is negative, and the Household member is well.

Child receives a Health Risk Alert (HRA)

- Student may attend school by providing a negative ART test.
- Social interactions should be kept to a minimum.
- Child's health should be monitored and kept home if symptoms develop.

A Household member of the Child receives a Health Risk Alert (HRA)

- Student may attend school.

There will be further details provided shortly about the protocol for exams, in cases where students are on an Approved Absences.
