BACKGROUND

ACS (International) is an independent, co-educational international secondary school located in Singapore catering for students from Year 1 (Grade 7) to Year 6 (Grade 12). Students sit the Cambridge IGCSE examinations in Years 3 and 4 (Grades 9 and 10) then progress to the IB Diploma in Years 5 and 6 (Grades 11 and 12).

Our aim is to develop future leaders with an international vision, moral character, intellectual ability and deep compassion for humanity based upon Christian belief and values.

ACS (International) is one of three Singaporean international schools able to enrol both local and international students. The student roll of approximately 1100 includes 50% of students who come from Singapore with the rest from 30 different countries around the world. Approximately 60% of the staff are Singaporean and the other 40% mainly from China, South Korea, Thailand and Japan.

ACS (International) is described as a 'Singaporean International School' offering a blend of local and international education providing Asian rigour within an international context.

HISTORY

The school is owned by the Methodist Church of Singapore and opened in 2005. It is one of six schools in Singapore. The first ACS school opened in 1886 with 13 students, and today over 10,000 students are enrolled in ACS schools across Singapore.

Our dual ACS and Christian heritage is a compass for our school and embodies such intangibles as tradition, excellence, pride in school, loyalty, Christian values, status and commitment. The stated ACS philosophy is "To create conditions for students to embody excellence, to establish an environment for spiritual, intellectual and physical growth, to prepare pupils to meet the challenge of rapid change in society". This is reflected in the school motto, "The Best Is Yet To Be." The phrase is taken from the first line of the "Robert Browning poem, Rabbi ben Ezra (1864)".

HOLISTIC EDUCATION

The House system is the basis of our pastoral care network and contributes to the 'family atmosphere' and holistic values of the school. Each House is led by a Head of House and supported by House Tutor teachers and student prefects. Strong pastoral support combined with inter-House activities, service work and weekly House assemblies are features of this programme. Strong co-curricular, leadership and service programmes complement the vertical House system. Over 40 co-curricular activities are offered; there are 200 formal leadership roles available to our 1100 students; and there were a range of over 20, international trips offered on a voluntary basis each year (pre-COVID-19 period) for community service, curriculum, sports, cultural exchange, university visits and Model United Nations.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

Students follow a general course in their first two years at school before selecting their subject combinations for the IGCSE two year course in Years 3 and 4 (Grades 9 and 10).

45% of our students have English as a Second Language. Those students who need to develop their English language skills are placed in a one year ESOL Bridging programme before entering the mainstream in the following year. All students take a second language – most students take their mother tongue language.

Most students entering the IB Diploma programme in Years 5 and 6 gain entry through sitting the IGCSE or local O Level examinations. Some students gain entry via our one year Foundation IB or Pre-IB Bridging programmes. These students must meet the same standards as those sitting the formal IGCSE or O Level examinations.

COVID-19 MEASURES

Following the directives from Singapore authorities like Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education, the school went on Home Based Learning from 17 to 28 May 2021 using online portals. When schools in Singapore were allowed to reopen, the school resumed lessons on site from end June with Safe Management Measures put in place.



ACS (International) students have gained 'Top in the World' awards since 2010 in the following subjects: English Literature, English Language, Mathematics, Additional Mathematics, Geography, Chinese and Physical Education.
