



IBDP EXAMINATION 2021 RESULTS

For the sixth year out of the last seven, ACS (International) students have achieved the perfect score of 45 points in the International Baccalaureate Examination. There are 8 perfect scorers this year, the highest ever in the school's history.

The average score was 39.25, which exceeds the previous school record of 36.1 which was set in 2018. This average is likely to be revised upwards after the appeal process is completed. 98% of students scored above the world average of 32.39, which is the best result in the school's history. 49.7% of students achieved a score of 40 or more. The overall pass rate was 100%.

As usual, a significant number of our students passed the IB Diploma, with English as their second language. This is particularly impressive as students firstly have to learn the English language, think in English, then write in the English academic style. Research usually suggests that it takes 7 years to become fully proficient in a second language, and most of these students achieved this in 3 to 6 years.

The top performing subjects, defined by over 50% of students achieving a grade 7, are as follows:

- Chinese B - Higher Level
- Chinese B - Standard Level
- French B – Standard Level
- Mandarin Ab Initio – Standard Level

- Psychology – Standard Level

- Sports Science – Higher Level
