The schools CCA policy for students is that all **students should have at least one activity CCA**. However, the school recognises that some students have existing commitments that take place outside of school. If these activities are organised, regular and purposeful then the school may consider that the activity could be used in place of a school based CCA. The final decision and approval will be given by the relevant Head of CCA when all other signatures have been obtained.
