#### **IBDP Admissions of Non-DSA IGCSE students**

For a number of students the IGCSE results will be used to determine whether they will be enrolled into the IB Diploma programme at ACS (International). Students and parents can find the school's Student Progression Policy on the website under "Life at ACS -> Community Policies". However, in simple terms, students need to achieve 3As and 3Bs in a combination that allows for an IB group of subjects to be selected.

Please note that enrolments are extremely limited in Psychology.

#### **Progression Procedure on Wednesday 19 January**

For students who qualify for IBDP at ACS (International) they and their parents are invited to come in the morning to discuss progression and suitable subject choices. The main IBDP subject consultation will take place from 8.30am to 12.30pm.

For students and parents who cannot make it in the morning they should call the school's main reception on +65 6472 1477 and arrange a time for later in the day.

### Support for Students who do not meet IBDP Progression Criteria

Students who do not meet the minimum criteria for progression to IBDP will be directed to the Higher Education staff for advice on other educational options. Staff will be available from 8:30am in Library Block Level 6.
