

Established in 1994, the ACS (Independent) Boarding School is home to about 500 students and staff. Each hall has carefully selected resident staff who provide a balance of academic and pastoral support.

The ACS (Independent) Boarding School aims to:

- Provide a comfortable, secure and caring environment for living and learning
- Inculcate moral and social values based on Christian principles and virtues
- Foster esprit d'corps and develop leadership potential in a closely knit community
- Enhance self-confidence and nurture a sense of communal responsibility
- Encourage holistic development through a wide range of enrichment, cultural, recreational and sporting activities

Management

The Warden of the Boarding School is the Principal of ACS (Independent) and the Deputy Wardens are Deputy Principals in the school. The Hall Masters and Hall Tutors are teachers from ACS (Independent) and ACS (International). They ensure that boarders receive the same high standard of education, care and support throughout the whole day.

The Warden is assisted in the day-to-day running of the Boarding School by various administrative, maintenance, cleaning, custodial and security staff.

Boarders' Room

Each Hall of Residence has 2 types of rooms – double room and single room.

The rooms are subject to availability and the allocation of boarders to double rooms is done by the Hall Staff, who takes into account the age, responsibility level, and specific needs of each boarder.

Each boarder has a personal study area (desk with chair), book shelf, bed, wardrobe and wastepaper bin. There is also additional storage under the bed for bulky items. Bed linen will be provided, although boarders can opt to use their own. Each room has attached bathroom facilities. Ceiling fans and air-conditioning* are also provided.

The rooms will be cleaned once a week. Boarders are still expected to dispose their own trash and maintain the cleanliness and tidiness of their own rooms.

*Air-conditioning in the bedrooms run from 10pm to 6.30am on weekdays and 10pm to 8am on weekends.



Services & Facilities

General

The Boarding School provides a number of services and facilities, in each hall, for the safety and well-being of our Boarders:


- Daily laundry (washing and ironing)

Nearby Amenities



ACS (Independent) Boarding School is located near ACS (International). The journey to school is about 20 to 30 minutes, depending on traffic, by public transportation. Buona Vista MRT station and one-north MRT station are around 5 minutes away by bus or 10 minutes by foot.

The Boarding School is also situated in an area that allows students easy access to clinics, supermarkets, eateries, group-buy collection points and malls.

Boarding Life & Activities

Termly Events

Life in the Boarding School is rich and fulfilling. The Junior Common Room Committee (JCRC) provides student leadership in sporting and adventure activities, cultural functions and special events. At the end of each term, there is a celebration which is also a cultural event:

Weekly Koinonia

As ACS (Independent) Boarding School operates based on Christian values, there are also weekly fellowship meetings, Koinionia, at which inspiring testimonies, songs, music and messages are shared between staff, boarders and invited guests.

Week Day Academic Support

Academic support is provided through 'Prep Time', a compulsory nightly two-hour homework and study preparation session, supervised by hall staff. Students are able to seek academic support from hall staff on duty.

Boarding Life Structure

Meal Time

Meals are freshly prepared by the Boarding School's in-house caterer. The meal times are as follows:

Breakfast	7am to 8.30am (Saturdays of school week) 8am to 9am (School Holidays)
Lunch	12pm to 1pm

Boarders would have to book for their meals through the online meal-booking system every Wednesday. To prevent food wastage and to educate boarders about it, food fines would be imposed when food is wasted.

Prep Time

Every Sunday to Thursday, students will have to attend compulsory Prep Time in the Prep Room, from 8pm to 10pm.

Reporting Time / Lights Out

On weekends, students have to be back in hall by 10.30pm (for Year 1 - 3 students) and 11pm (for Year 4 - 6 students).
