International Students – Early Leave Term 2

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we head towards the end of Term 2 many of you will be looking forward to welcoming your child back to your home for a few weeks. We hope that this time will be special and that you enjoy spending time with them over the mid-year break.

Students may leave school from the evening of 27 May 2022 onwards. The school does not approve early leave for students as teachers will be teaching the curriculum up to the very last day. However, the school understands that for students returning to China they need to serve 7 days of isolation in Singapore prior to their departure. To allow for this, the school will grant students who are returning to China approved leave from Friday 20 May (inclusive) so that they may have completed 7 full days of isolation prior to Friday 27 May. To formalise this, you must apply to the respective Vice-Principal for your child's division.

We expect all students to return to Singapore and commence school on time; Year 4 (IGCSE) and Year 6 students on Monday 4 July and other year levels (including FIB and Pre-IB) on Wednesday 6 July. Year 4 (IGCSE) and Year 6 students have their Preliminary exams starting on Monday 4 July which are mandatory for all students to take. For IGCSE students, these exams can provide Direct School Admission (DSA) into the IBDP programme for 2023. For Year 6 students, these exams are used as the basis for their Predicted Grades for University applications. There will be no opportunity for students to re-sit Preliminary examinations should they miss them.

The school wishes you and your family all the very best for the mid-year break.
