PART 2C: GUARDIANSHIP, MEDICAL INSURANCE AND ACCOMMODATION

GUARDIANSHIP - All parents who live overseas, or who are not immediately accessible whilst their child is at school, are required to have a guardian who is a resident in Singapore. The guardian's role is to, with a strong understanding of the school operations and regular communications with the school staff, support the student and to deputise for the parents when they are not available. A guardian may be a relative or close friend of the parents but they **must be Singaporeans (Citizens/Permanent Residents) and speak English fluently**. As guardians are in a responsible position, they should be **at least thirty (30) years of age**. Male guardians for female wards are **NOT permitted**. Parents are to **use only guardians registered and endorsed by the school**. **THE SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO NOT ENDORSE GUARDIANS IT DEEMS UNFIT.**

HOSPITALISATION AND SURGICAL INSURANCE - International students requiring student pass are required to maintain a valid medical insurance (with a coverage S\$50,000) while they are studying with ACS (International). This insurance must be purchased through the school and will be charged with the first semester fees each year.

SCHOOL BOARDING AND HOMESTAYING - International students requiring student pass are required to board with ACS Hostels for the first year of study at ACS (International). International students who plan to subsequently move out to private boarding (from second year onwards) must apply through the International Pastoral Coordinator (IPC) and must only use homestay families endorsed by ACS (International). **THE SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO NOT ENDORSE HOMESTAY FAMILIES IT DEEMS UNFIT.** No students are permitted to reside in un-supervised privately rented properties.

Specific Guardianship Guidelines

- Work directly with parents and wards to establish a personal working relationship; and with school on ward's abnormalities outside school/absenteeism/ medical attention/withdrawal from school/any issues rendering the school's attention;
- Assist with airport pick-up, viewing of the school and interview with dormitory for the parents and/or ward; as well as ward's student pass, health insurance and school trips travel arrangements;
- Monitor and liaise with school and parents on the ward's health and well-being, academic progression, disciplinary and social behaviour;
- Accompany parents and/or wards to school events (Orientation, Parent-Teacher Meetings etc.) where needed;

Specific Accommodation Guidelines

- Provide meals to boarder, appropriate level of laundry service;
- Provide sufficient areas and supervision to ensure a safe and conducive environment for living and studies in the evenings and weekends;
- Monitor and liaise with guardians and parents on the ward's health and well-being, academic progression, disciplinary and social behaviour;
- Work with guardians to provide regular update on boarder behaviours/progression as well as abnormalities outside school/absenteeism/ medical attention/withdrawal from school/any issues rendering the school's attention;

WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

A withdrawal notice in writing to the Principal's Office is expected to officiate withdrawal. Students without serving notice of withdrawal will be deemed to be progressing to the next academic year, and shall pay school fees according to the terms of the Student Contract and/or official invoice. Places will be reserved only upon receipt of school fees within the stipulated deadline.

REFUND POLICY

Tuition Fees for Newly Admitted Students

- 100% refund if notice is received more than 30 days before course commencement.
- 50% refund if notice is received less than 31 days before course commencement.
- 25% refund if notice is received 1–60 days after course commencement.
- NO refund if notice is received 61 days after course commencement.

Deposit

- 100% refund if a minimum 3-month's notice is received in writing to the school and an acknowledgement is ascertained from the Principal's Office.
- NO refund if notice is NOT received.
- NO refund for Years 5 or 6 students with early withdrawal.
- Any balance is refunded 4–6 weeks from the date the Refund Advice Form is received, after deductions of all outstanding amounts (e.g. school camps, examination fees or losses or breakage of school property).
