All students take a common course as per the table above. Bridging students will undertake intensive English language tuition in their specialist classes but other subjects such as Mathematics, Sciences and Humanities are identical to the Mainstream programme.

Singaporean and Singaporean PR students follow the MOE Mother Tongue Language (MTL) framework. If a student has been exempted from MTL they are still required to study a foreign language that is offered by the school. All Singaporean and Singaporean PR students are required to take up a 2nd language.

Entry Requirements

- Applicants will be considered for admission based on the strength of their academic achievements and additional interviews/tests if required.
- International applicants are required to sit for an admission exams of English and Mathematics.
- Singaporean and Singaporean PR applicants applying for Year 1 may use their PSLE results in place of the admissions exams. To be considered for entry, applicants must score a minimum PSLE aggregate of AL20 points or below and have been offered Express stream by MOE.
- · All applicants, regardless of nationality will also be assessed in their performance via an interview.
- · Applicants with previous experience of being taught completely in English may apply directly for the mainstream programmes.
- Applicants who are not previously taught in English can only apply to Bridging or Pre-IGCSE programmes.
