IBDP Admissions of Non-DSA IGCSE students

For a number of students, the IGCSE results will be used to determine whether they will be enrolled into the IB Diploma programme at ACS (International). Students and parents can find the school's Student Progression Policy here. However, in simple terms, students need to achieve 3As and 3Bs in a combination that allows for an IB group of subjects to be selected.

Progression Procedure on Thursday 19 January

For students wishing to pursue IB studies or for those who need assistance finding a new education provider, there will be counsellors available on the day. Students and parents are invited to come in the morning to discuss progression. For students and parents who cannot make it in the morning they should call the school's General Office on $+65\ 6472\ 1477$ and arrange for another time.

The main IBDP subject consultation will take place from 8.45am to 12.30pm in the Conference Room next to the General Office.

Support for Students who do not meet IBDP Progression Criteria

Students who do not meet the minimum criteria for progression to IBDP will be directed to the Higher Education staff for advice on other educational options. Staff will be available from 8:45am to 1:00pm.

Optional Higher Education Guidance Session

IBDP Induction Sessions

For non-DSA students who are admitted to the IBDP programme there is an Induction Programme on Friday 20 January starting at 8.45am in Oldham Chapel that is compulsory to attend. Thereafter, they will attend a session on CAS until 11.30am.
