ACS (International) congratulates the Graduating Class of 2022 on their outstanding IBDP results. The cohort had a 100% pass rate and achieved an average score of 38 points which is expected to rise after re-marks are complete. 94% of our students achieved scores over the IB World Average of 30.91 points, with 45% gaining a score of over 40 points. We are particularly proud of the two students who received a perfect score of 45 points.
