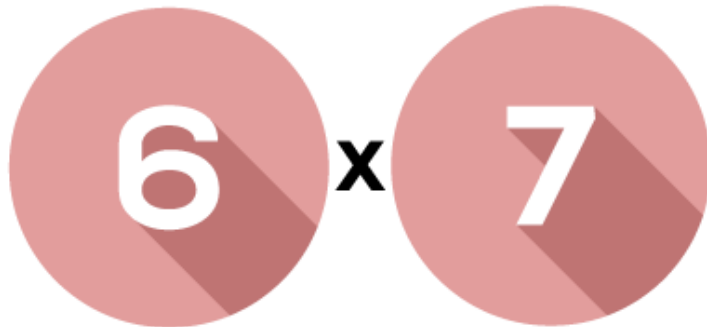
## Q: What is the minimum score for IBDP curriculum ?

- the minimum passing score is **24 points** (out of 45) + following conditions
- Numeric grades (as opposed to an “N”) have been awarded in all six subjects registered for the IB diploma.
- All **CAS** requirements have been met.
- At least D for both Theory of Knowledge and an Extended Essay.
- There is no grade 1 in any subject.
- There are no more than two grade 2s awarded.
- There are no more than three grade 3s or below awarded.
- At least 12 points have been gained on Higher Level subjects.
- At least 9 points have been gained on Standard Level subjects.
