

LEADERSHIP COLOURS AWARD

Objectives of Awards

- a. To give recognition to students for their leadership development and practice.
- b. To commend exemplary conduct, demonstrating the school IGNITE values and IB Learner Profile.

Types of Awards

Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards are given to deserving students. Years 2 and 4 awardees receive their awards at Speech Day, and the Year 6 awardees at Graduation ceremony.

Criteria

- a. The awards are given to deserving Years 2, 4 and 6 yearly.
- b. The awards are presented to students who have displayed high levels of competence in leadership development and practice, and commitment to the community in service and action.
- c. The awards are not automatically awarded to students holding a student leadership position.
- d. The selection criteria include consistently good conduct and leadership competence and influence, in line with the general expectation of the age group they are in. They must have demonstrated IGNITE values and/or IB Learner Profile attributes in each of the categories below.
- e. Reference will also be made to their conduct records.
- I. Citizenship [Noble character, Principled, Open minded]
 - being clear about personal values and beliefs, and behave consistently with these values
 - inspire a shared vision to serve or do good to their community
 - show respect for social, cultural and community diversity

II. Modelling the Way [Caring, Balanced, Reflective]

- infuse team/others with energy and confidence
- foster collaborating
- coach or encourage other people
- manage personal and emotional relationships

III. Inspiration [Excellence, Tenacity, Integrity, Risk Taker]

- show positivity in the face of challenges and failures
- celebrate success and managing disappointment
- innovate, experiment, and explore ways to improve
- exude enthusiasm for the work/project/event
- · are trustworthy

Iv. Achievements [Excellence, Tenacity]

- successful completion of projects/events
- significant achievement/recognition

The three awards given are as follows:

GOLD AWARD

- Students who have demonstrated an excellent level in the four aspects:
- Citizenship
- Modelling
- Inspiration
- Contribution (within and beyond school)

SILVER AWARD

- Students who have demonstrated a highly commendable level in the four aspects:
- Citizenship
- Modelling
- Inspirational
- Contribution

BRONZE AWARD

- Students who have demonstrated a commendable level in the three aspects:
- Citizenship
- Modelling
- Inspirational
- Contribution

General Rules & Procedures for Nomination

The awards are given based on the performance of the students during the period under review, usually over the two years' period.

Students' reflections and applications will require the endorsement of two staff. They can be their HOHs, House Tutors, CCA teachers and/or teachers.

Staff are invited to give feedback on the applications, wherever relevant.

The awarding panel comprising of the school senior leaders (SLT) will make the final decisions.
