

Media release on ACS (International) Elementary School

Anglo-Chinese School (International) is expanding its reach through the establishment of an elementary school for international students in Singapore.

The new school, ACS (International) Elementary, will be on the same site as the current ACS (International) campus in Holland Village. The pupils will follow the Cambridge Primary curriculum offered by Cambridge International Education. The new Elementary and existing Secondary school will have staggered start and finish times.

Under the Compulsory Education Act, Singaporeans must undergo primary school education in government or government-aided schools, therefore the school will only be enrolling international students into the elementary school.

Almost half of ACS (International)'s student cohort comprises of international students, including Chinese, South Korean, Japanese, Malaysian and Indonesian students. One former student is Indonesian President Joko Widodo's younger son Kaesang Pangarep, who graduated in 2016.

Mr Tan Wah Thong, the Chair of ACS (International) says "We are glad to have the opportunity to enable more young people to benefit from the ACS brand of education, known for developing well-rounded students, many of whom have become leaders in industry and government."
