Road Safety and Consideration During School Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As part of our ongoing commitment to the safety and wellbeing of our students, families, and neighbours, we are writing to ask for your continued cooperation during school drop-off and pick-up times. The roads surrounding the school are shared spaces, and how we use them has a direct impact on student safety, pedestrian access, and our relationship with the local community.

For the safety of all, we seek the co-operation of all parents driving to school to exercise care and consideration by adhering to the following:

- Do not park in front of the access of any residential unit.
- Refrain from waiting/parking illegally. It is an offence to park/wait on either side of a road demarcated by a continuous white line or double yellow lines.
- Turn off your engines when waiting to pick up your child from school. With many cars waiting outside the school, the noise of car engines can be quite disturbing to the residents.
- Drive at a safe speed that is below the legal speed limit along the roads near school. The pavements are narrow and often blocked which results in pedestrians, including students, having to walk on the road. Drivers should be mindful of this and reduce their speed.
- Please do not beep your horn to get your child's attention or at other cars as this is a noise nuisance to our neighbours.
- Plan your pick-up time with your child to reduce the queuing/waiting time along the road.
- Be considerate and allow cars from side roads access into the car queue waiting to exit to Holland Village.
- In the morning, do not cut in the queue when turning from Holland Avenue to Taman Warna.

We greatly appreciate the care and thought shown by the vast majority of families each day. By working together and being mindful of our surroundings, we can continue to ensure a safe, respectful, and positive environment for our students and the wider community.
